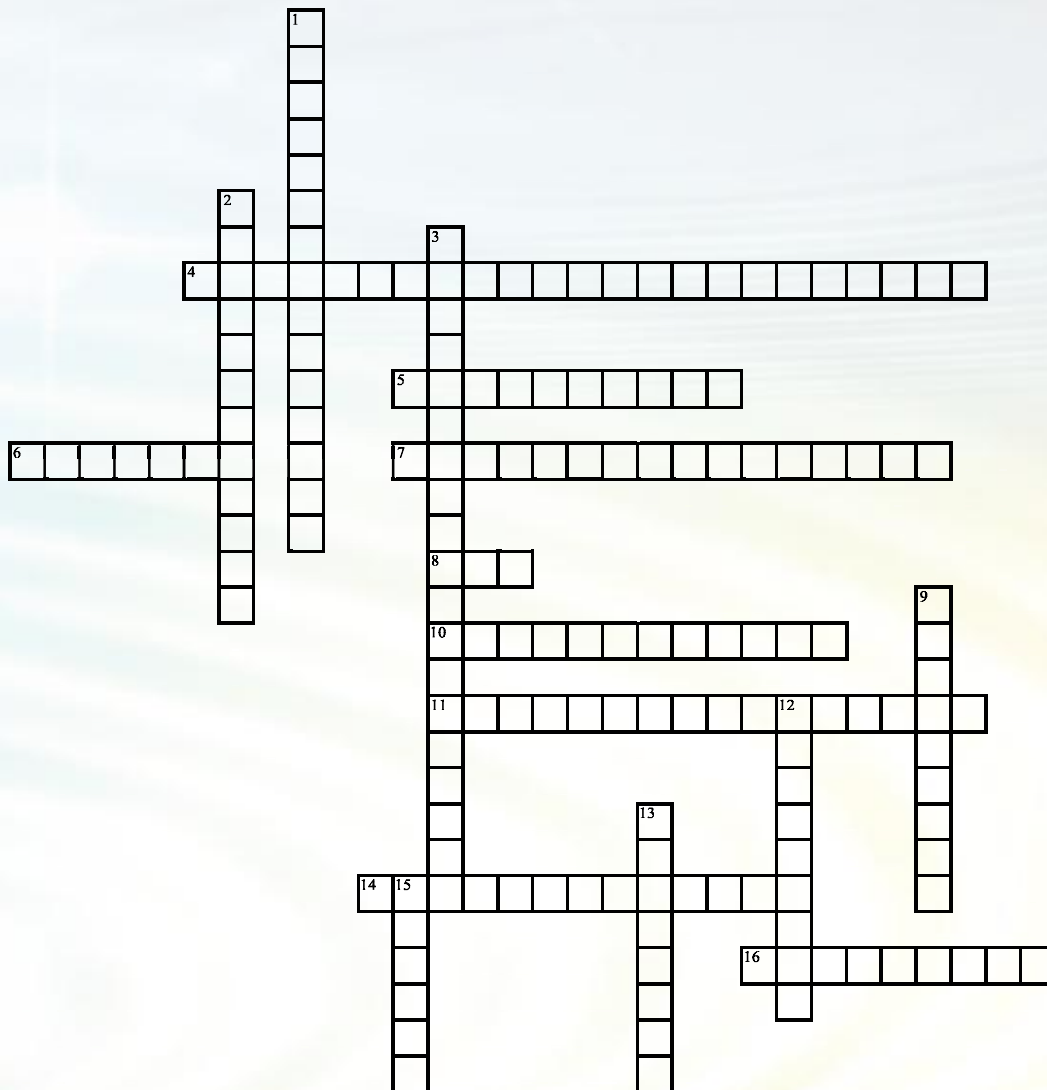


AIA Puzzler
