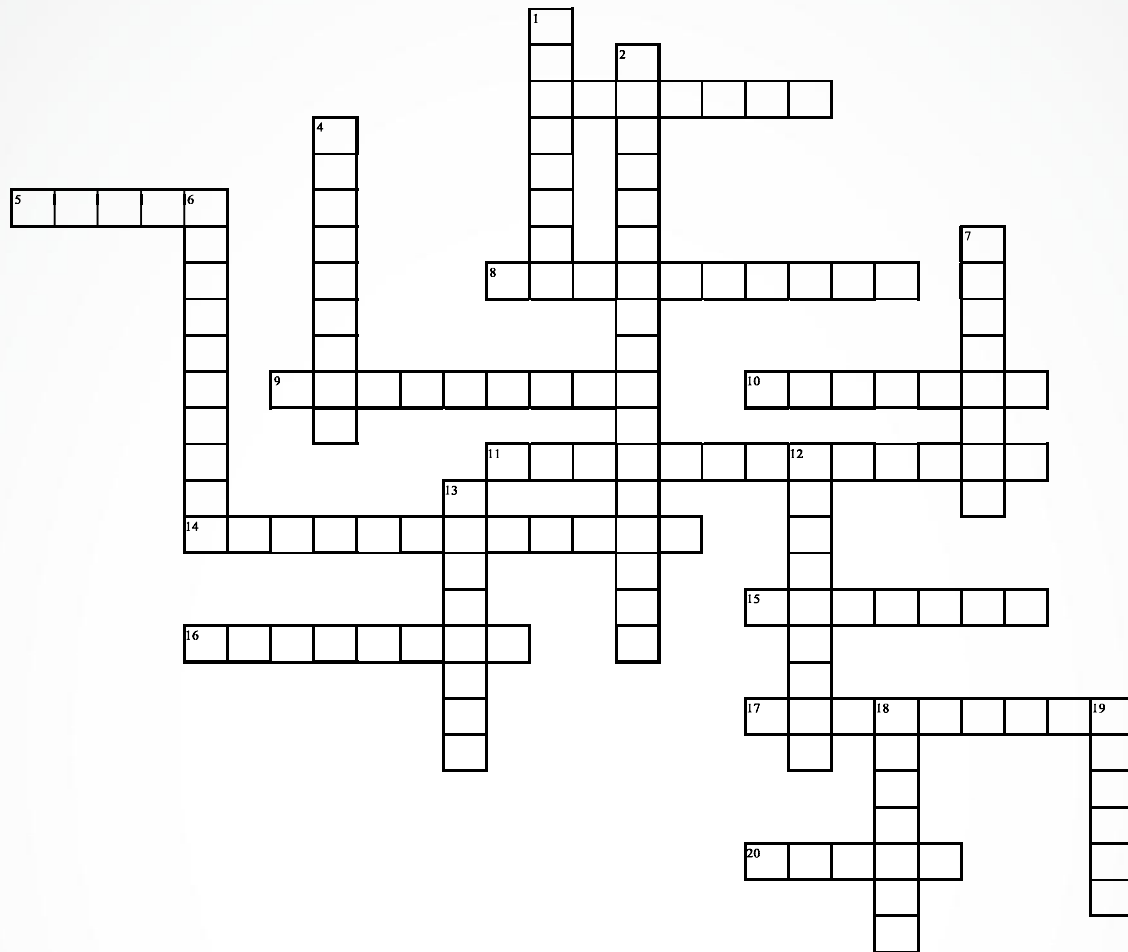


AIA Puzzler
